

PERKY PETALS HAIR SCRUNCHIE



For this project you will need:

- 10" WOF of your desired fabric (I used quilting cotton) for size S, M or L single pair of Perky Petals per scrunchie OR
14" WOF of your desired fabric if making double or triple pairs of Perky Petals per scrunchie
- a 6.5" length of elastic (I used 1/4" or 6mm because that's all I had at the time) for size L OR a 5" length of elastic for M and 4.5" length of elastic for S size scrunchie.
- Rotary cutter or scissors
- Quilting ruler
- Pinker or pinking shears (if you have some)
- Safety pin or fabric turner tool
- Provided Pattern Pieces
 - A = Large Size Petal
 - B = Medium Size Petal
 - C = Small Size Petal

Once you have gathered the required equipment and cut out the pattern piece below, cut a strip of fabric either 4" X 24" (or for a scrunchier look 4" X 30") for sizes L & M Petals OR 3.5" X 18" for a size S scrunchie, and set aside.

From the remaining fabric, **cut 2** of the petal pattern piece you chose **ON THE FOLD**. (If you wish to make a double or triple Perky Petals Scrunchie, either cut 2 of each of A and B for a medium or large size double Scrunchie, or 2 of each of B and C for a small size scrunchie. For a triple, cut 2 of EACH petal pattern piece.)



Going back to your 4" X 24"(or 3.5" X 18") strip, fold 3/8" back from one edge and either press or finger press it.

Unfold the fold you just made and using a 3/8" seam allowance, fold the 4" X 24" (30") strip LENGTHWISE and sew a seam the entire length of the fabric. Turn right side out and tuck the 3/8" edge back inside the tube.



Take the piece of elastic and attach a safety pin to one end. Feed the elastic through the tube, scrunching it as you go so that you can grab both ends when you're through to the other end.



Sew the two ends of the elastic together to form a ring, making sure you don't twist it.

Place raw end of fabric tube inside the folded end and sew along edge to close the scrunchie.



Now for the perky petals! Take the 2 pattern pieces and place them right sides together. Sew a 1/4" seam all around, leaving a 1" gap for turning.

Pink or clip seams and turn right way out, turning under the section that was not sewn and topstitch around the entire outer edge.



Fold fabric so both petal tips are even and place under scrunchie and, keeping both ends even, tie onto the scrunchie and fluff out petals to your desired "look."



Viola! You are done! Make a ton more, or, sit back with a cuppa and some chocolate (to help grease your creativity!) and admire your handiwork!
